AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-2059, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CERTIFICATE
OF TITLE AND REGISTRATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2059, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2059. Obtaining a certificate of title; revocation

5 A. If satisfactory proof of ownership is furnished to the director,
6 the director may issue a certificate of title for a motor vehicle, trailer or
7 semitrailer whether or not a certificate of title has ever been issued for
8 that motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer.

9 B. If the director determines that an applicant for a certificate of
10 title to a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer is not entitled to a
11 certificate of title, the director may refuse to issue a certificate or to
12 register the vehicle and, after notice and a hearing, the director may revoke
13 a registration already acquired or an outstanding certificate of title. The
14 director shall serve the notice in person or by ~~regular~~ **FIRST CLASS**
15 mail. Within fifteen days after the date the notice is delivered or mailed,
16 the applicant may request a hearing.
