AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-1602; RELATING TO UNIVERSITIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 13, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 15-1602, to read:
4 15-1602. Advisory boards of each university; members; terms;
5 duties of Arizona board of regents
6 A. EACH PUBLIC UNIVERSITY IN THIS STATE SHALL ESTABLISH AN ADVISORY
7 BOARD TO SUBMIT WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS ON BEHALF OF THAT UNIVERSITY TO THE
8 ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS. THE ADVISORY BOARD OF EACH UNIVERSITY SHALL
9 CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WHO SERVE EIGHT YEAR TERMS, TO BEGIN AND END
10 ON THE THIRD MONDAY IN JANUARY:
11 1. ONE MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.
12 2. ONE MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
13 REPRESENTATIVES.
14 3. THREE MEMBERS WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO SECTION
15 38-211.
16 B. ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS SHALL TAKE THE OATH OF OFFICE BEFORE
17 ENTERING ON THE DUTIES OF OFFICE.
18 C. ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS ARE IMMUNE FROM PERSONAL LIABILITY WITH
19 RESPECT TO ALL ACTS DONE AND ACTIONS TAKEN IN GOOD FAITH WITHIN THE SCOPE OF
20 THEIR AUTHORITY DURING DULY CONSTITUTED REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS WITH
21 APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF THEIR RESPECTIVE BOARD.
22 D. ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS DETERMINED
23 PURSUANT TO SECTION 38-611 FOR EACH DAY OF ATTENDANCE AT BOARD MEETINGS,
24 EXCEPT THAT COMPENSATION OF ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL NOT EXCEED FIVE
25 HUNDRED DOLLARS IN ANY YEAR.
26 E. IF THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS DECLINES TO FOLLOW A WRITTEN
27 RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED BY A UNIVERSITY ADVISORY BOARD PURSUANT TO THIS
28 SECTION, THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, AT A REGULARLY SCHEDULED PUBLIC
29 MEETING, SHALL:
30 1. ALLOW AN OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES OF THAT UNIVERSITY
31 AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION.
32 2. ADOPT A RESOLUTION THAT SETS FORTH THE SPECIFIC REASONS THE ARIZONA
33 BOARD OF REGENTS DECLINED TO FOLLOW THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ADVISORY BOARD.
34 Sec. 2. Initial terms of members of advisory boards of each
35 university
36 A. Notwithstanding section 15-1602, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added
37 by this act, the initial terms of members of the advisory boards of each
38 university are as follows:
39 1. For members appointed pursuant to section 15-1602, subsection A,
40 paragraph 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, the terms shall begin and end on the
41 third Monday in January 2015.
42 2. For members appointed pursuant to section 15-1602, subsection A,
43 paragraph 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, the terms shall begin and end on the
44 third Monday in January 2016.

1 3. For members appointed pursuant to section 15-1602, subsection A,
2 paragraph 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, one term from each university's
3 advisory board shall begin and end on the third Monday in January 2017, one
4 term from each university's advisory board shall begin and end on the third
5 Monday in January 2018 and one term from each university's advisory board
6 shall begin and end on the third Monday in January 2019.
7 B. All subsequent appointments shall be as prescribed by statute.
