1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be
4 repealed as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 Article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, relating
7 to the legislative vote required to increase state revenues, is
8 repealed.

9 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
10 at the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of
11 Arizona.
