A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled
"The social welfare act,"
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 10c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 10C. (1) NOT LATER THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
2 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
3 ESTABLISH A PROGRAM OF RANDOM SUBSTANCE ABUSE TESTING AS A
4 CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT.

5 (2) IF A RECIPIENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE, THE
6 RECIPIENT SHALL BE INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT
7 FOR NOT LESS THAN 180 DAYS. AFTER 180 DAYS, THE RECIPIENT SHALL BE
8 RETESTED FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MUST TEST NEGATIVE FOR SUBSTANCE

1 ABUSE IN ORDER TO HAVE HIS OR HER ASSISTANCE RESTORED.
